Residents Invited to Discuss Madison Street Landscape Designs

Two open public meetings have been scheduled to review options for landscaping improvements to the Madison Street Corridor. Meetings will be held from noon to 2 p.m., Wed., Nov. 17 and Wed., Dec. 1, in Village Hall, 123 Madison St.

Residents are invited to participate in a discussion with Village staff, business district representatives and consultants from Schreiber Anderson Associates (SAA) of Madison, Wisconsin, who were hired to evaluate existing landscape features and prepare designs for island medians, main intersections and irrigation systems along the entire length of Madison Street from Harlem Avenue to Austin Boulevard.

SAA is scheduled to complete the design phase by the end of the year. Landscaping then would be completed in conjunction with the Madison Street resurfacing project scheduled for the spring of 2005.

The Village Board approved the contract with SAA in early October, following a competitive bid process.
