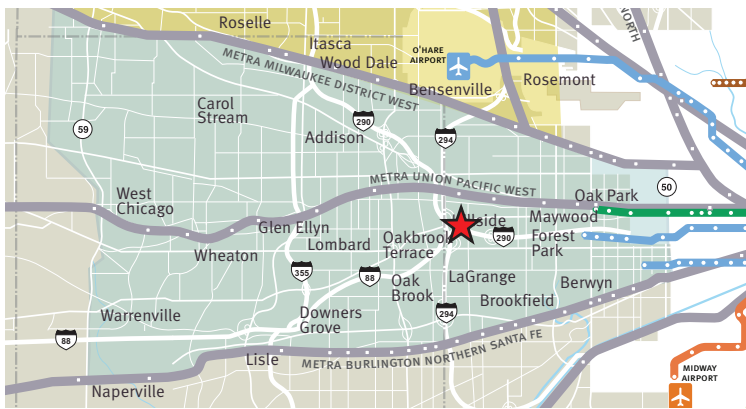


# Cook-DuPage Corridor
