RECYCLE

CFL bulbs contain small amounts of mercury, an essential ingredient for CFL bulbs to produce light. While the amount of mercury inside a CFLs glass tubing is only about 5 milligrams - roughly the amount that would cover the tip of a ballpoint pen - it is still essential to handle and recycle CFLs responsibly.

CFLs may be taken to the Household Chemical and Electronic Recycling facility in Chicago (Goose Island) at 1150 N. North Branch Street (Division and the Chicago River). They are open Tuesday mornings 7 am to noon, Thursday afternoons 2 pm to 7 pm and the first Saturday of the month from 8 am to 3 pm. They also take household hazardous waste and computer equipment (e-scrap). For general information call 312.744.7672
