### Workshop to Help Property Owners Practice Energy Efficiency

A workshop to help business and home owners make their properties more energy efficient is scheduled for Fri., May 9, in the Dole Learning Center, 355 Augusta St. One-hour sessions are scheduled at 8:30 a.m. for business owners and 10 a.m. for residential property owners.

Experts will offer technical assistance, educational materials and demonstrations on how to solve many common energy wasting problems.

For homeowners, the discussions will include energy conservation products and rebate programs. A limited number of \$10 rebates will be given to attendees to use toward the purchase of qualifying products at two local hardware stores.

Business owners also will learn about grants that could help fund technology upgrades to reduce energy demands.
