Village Board Forum to Take Citizen Input Via Telephone

Residents will be able to participate in the next open dialogue with the Village Board via telephone. The dialogue is the third in a series of quarterly meetings and is scheduled for 7 - 10 p.m., Wed., Oct. 27 at Village Hall, 123 Madison St.

The call-in option will allow residents watching the live television broadcast of the meeting to participate by calling the telephone number scrolled on the screen throughout the meeting. The meeting will be broadcast on VOP-TV6, the government access television station available to Oak Park cable subscribers on channel 6.

While only one caller will be able to talk at a time, up to 12 callers can be placed in a queue for their chance to participate.

Topics will be considered on a first-raised, first-addressed basis. Discussion will be limited to 45 minutes per topic to ensure sufficient time to address at least four topics per session.

As with past sessions, the format will be relatively informal to encourage interaction among residents and Board members.
