Village Schedules Test for Entry-Level Police Officers

The Oak Park Police Department will test for entry-level officers on Sat., Feb. 12, at Oak Park and River Forest High School, 201 N. Scoville Ave. A mandatory orientation session will begin promptly at 9 a.m., with the test to immediately follow.

A valid driver's license and a birth certificate or proof of U.S. citizenship must be presented in order to take the exam, which is expected to conclude by noon.

Applications will be distributed immediately following the written exam and must be returned by Wed., Feb. 16 along with a \$10 application fee.

To qualify as an Oak Park police officer, a candidate must be a U.S. citizen at least 21 years old before Feb. 12, speak and understand English and have at least 60 hours of college credit from an accredited college or university with a grade average of "C" or better. Certified grade transcripts must be provided by March 14.

The entry-level salary is \$47,700.
