Public Hearing Scheduled to Discuss Proposed Parking Rules Revisions

Revisions to parking policies under review by the Parking and Traffic Commission will be discussed at a public hearing scheduled for 7:30 p.m., Tues., June 14 in Council Chambers of Village Hall, 123 Madison St.

Items to be discussed include policies for how requests should be made for loading zones, accessible parking, valet parking and bicycle parking. Processes for requesting various types of parking restrictions and signage also will be discussed.

The revisions under review are part of an ongoing Village-wide parking study that includes evaluating current on-street parking regulations, developing uniformity in restrictions and investigating strategies for balancing supply and demand.

Input from residents at public hearings help the citizen volunteers of the Parking and Traffic Commission determine if recommendations for changes should be considered by the Village Board.
