Police Distribute Flyer in Search of Person of Interest in Homicide Investigation

Oak Park police officers spent much of Monday afternoon walking door to door passing out flyers with a description and computer-generated composite sketches of an individual they wish to question in relation to last week's homicide of resident Peter D'Agostino.

Potentially more important than the description of the individual is a description of the automobile the individual is believed to have been driving, police say. The older model, mid-sized passenger vehicle is described as turquoise or light blue, with a maroon or dark colored front passenger side fender.

Copies of the flyer also were distributed to all area news media outlets, posted on the Village's website www.oak-park.us and cable television station, and hand delivered to the headquarters of each Chicago police district.

"The individual depicted in the flyer is not a suspect, but a person of interest we wish to question who can be placed on the block around the time of the homicide," said Oak Park Police Chief Rick C. Tanksley.

He urged anyone having any information regarding the person or vehicle to call the Oak Park police at 708.386.3800, the station's main number which is manned 24 hours a day.

The individual police are seeking to question is described as a black male with medium complexion; in his mid 20's to mid-30's; five-feet-10 inches to six-feet-two inches tall; and thin to medium build. He was last seen wearing a white baseball cap or *doo rag*, white t-shirt and white nylon running pants with a black stripe on the leg.

D'Agostino, 42, was found unconscious in the 1100 block of South Harvey Avenue at 5:32 p.m., last Wednesday. He later died from blunt force trauma to the head, according to the Cook County Medical Examiner.
