**Changes to Holley Court Garage Favor Shoppers, Increase Spaces**

Regular users of the Holley Court Parking Garage will notice changes beginning Nov. 14 when permit holders will be restricted to level two and above, and the lower levels reserved for hourly parkers.

"The intent of the parking restriction is to attract and better accommodate drivers who come to the downtown business district as customers," said Parking Services Manager Alva Johnson. "The change is likely to be even more effective during the upcoming holiday shopping season."

All parkers also should benefit from restriping currently underway, according to Johnson. The angle of spaces is being changed to add about 50 more parking spaces, he said. Parking will be restricted in the garage from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. on levels where restriping activity is underway. Contractors are using virtually noiseless equipment to reduce the effect on area residents.

Once the restrictions are in place, data from the electronic keycards permit parkers use to access the garage will be closely monitored to ensure compliance with the new rules. Permit holders who park their cars in the restricted hourly areas will be ticketed.
