Village Hall Hours Extended for Primary Election Early Voters

Village Hall hours will be extended for residents wishing to vote early or cast absentee ballots in the March 21 Primary Election. The Office of the Village Clerk will be open from 8 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Mondays (Feb. 27, March 6, 13 and 20) and Thursdays (March 2, 9 and 16), and from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturdays (March 4, 11 and 18). Regular hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Early voting is scheduled for February 27 through March 16, and absentee voting is scheduled for March 17 - 20. Early voters do not need to cite a reason for voting early, but absentee voters will be required to select a reason.

Residents voting early must be registered and present government-issued photo identification, such as an Illinois driver's License, state identification card or passport. Individuals have until Feb. 21 to register. Two types of identification are required to register to vote, at least one with a current address.
