Open House to Provide Information on Upcoming Construction Projects

An open house to address upcoming capital improvement projects is scheduled for 6 to 9 p.m., Thurs., April 6, in Room 101 of Village Hall, 123 Madison Street. Any resident or business owner with questions regarding Public Works projects is invited.

Village staff, as well as representatives from Strand Engineering, Terra Engineering and Nicor Gas, will be present to explain what to expect during construction, share approximate timelines of individual projects and discuss procedures. Renderings of the new Public Works Facility and maps of construction areas also will be displayed.

Capital improvement projects scheduled for 2006 include water and sewer main improvements, street resurfacing, alley reconstruction, streetscaping along Chicago Avenue, construction of the new Public Works Facility, improvements to the Home Avenue pedestrian bridge and Nicor Gas improvements to its delivery lines.

The construction season generally runs from May through November. Residents and business owners whose streets and alleys will be affected by construction are notified by letter prior to actual work beginning.
