Deadline Extended to be in July 4th Parade

The deadline for clubs and organizations to register to participate in the sixth annual Independence Day Parade has been extended to June 19. Registration forms are available at Village Hall, 123 Madison St., via email to community@oak-park.us or on the Village website, www.oak-park.us.

Participants are invited to bring a float, march, play music, carry balloons or banners, ride decorated bicycles, skate, drive vintage cars or just dress up to commemorate our nation's birthday. Owners of motorized vehicles must provide proof of insurance with their registration.

The parade will begin at 10 a.m., Tues., July 4, marching north on Ridgeland Avenue from Adams Street and dispersing at Whittier School (Augusta Street and Cuyler Avenue) where children's entertainment will be sponsored by the Park District of Oak Park. Participants will line up at 9 a.m.

The parade is organized by the volunteers of Community Relations Commission. Some 70 groups participated last year.
