Comments are being sought on five conceptual options developed to foster the public's ideas and generate early input in the development process. The concepts are very general and do not include specific potential improvements, but represent distinctly different approaches to improving Corridor mobility, officials say. As concepts move more toward more specific improvement proposals, additional opportunities for public review and comment will be scheduled, most likely later this year.

The meetings will be open house in format, with brief presentations to provide background on the Cook DuPage Corridor study. Representatives from the RTA and the Corridor's oversight committees will be at each of the meetings to answer questions.
