Lake Street Neighborhood plan to be presented

The final draft of the Lake Street Neighborhood Plan will be presented to the community at 7 p.m., Tues., Feb. 13 in Council Chambers of Village Hall, 123 Madison St.

Representatives from the planning team of Solomon Cordwell Buenz, Business Districts Inc., Fish Transportation Group and Wiss Janney, Elstner Associates, Inc., will present the recommendations that were created with the help of neighborhood residents and business operators.

The study area is from Austin Boulevard to Ridgeland Avenue, including the transit area at South Boulevard. The study assessed the livability, vibrancy and ambiance of the area as it relates to potential future development, and includes an architectural survey of the building stock along the corridor.
