Early Voting offered at Village Hall

Village Hall will be one of the 32 sites in suburban Cook County for individuals wishing to vote early for the April 17 Consolidated Election. Early voting will be offered at Village Hall, 123 Madison St., from Mon., March 26 through Thurs., April 12.

Ballots may be cast during normal business hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 9 a.m. to noon on two Saturdays, March 31 and April 7. Early voters do not need to cite a reason for voting early.

Early voters must be registered and present government-issued photo identification, such as an Illinois driver's license, state identification card or passport. The deadline to register to vote is 5 p.m., Tues., March 20. Two types of identification are required to register to vote, at least one with a current address.

In-person absentee voting will not be conducted at the early voting sites, including Village Hall. However, in-person absentee voting will be conducted on April 13 – 16 at the Office of the Cook County Clerk, 69 W. Washington St.

The April 17 Consolidated Election ballot will include candidates for the following Oak Park governmental bodies:

- Village Board
- Library Board
- School District 97 Board
- School District 200 Board
- Park District Board
