Foreclosure assistance offered at Homeowners' Outreach Day in Maywood

Oak Park residents and property owners concerned about home loan mortgage payments are invited to a *Homeowners' Outreach Day* in Maywood on Sat., Aug. 9. The event will be held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the Maywood Multi-Purpose Building, 200 S. 5th Ave.

The goal of *Outreach Day* is for homeowners in distress over potential foreclosure to meet with representatives of counseling agencies, lenders and other local organizations who can offer foreclosure assistance. Some seven lenders and five counselors will be available to meet one-on-one with homeowners.

Those attending the event are encouraged to bring the following documents to tailor the experience to their individual needs.

- Last mortgage statement
- Closing documents or refinance documents
- List of any other mortgages or liens against your property
- Current property tax and insurance information
- List of all monthly expenses (bring most recent bill or statement)
- Monthly income, including pay statements, any social security or other income
- Bank statements
- Reason for delinquency (current hardship)
- All delinquency correspondence if applicable

Homeowners' Outreach Day is sponsored by State Representative Karen Yarbrough in collaboration with the Illinois Housing Development Authority, Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, approved lenders and HUD-certified housing consultants.
