### **Nominations Sought for Historic Preservation Awards**

Nominations for the 2009 Historic Preservation Awards Program are now being sought by the Oak Park Historic Preservation Commission, citizen volunteers who advise the Village Board on historic preservations issues. April 13 is the deadline for submissions.

Single-family residences, apartment buildings, commercial buildings, public/institutional buildings and religious structures may be nominated in the following categories – restoration, rehabilitation, adaptive use and additions/new construction. Additional awards are presented for stewardship, detail and design.

Projects should have been created within the past five years, and located within the boundaries of the Village. Nominations need not be in an historic district. Interior work also may be considered in conjunction with exterior work.

Any resident, owner or tenant of eligible structures, members of local preservation and historical societies, and members of the Oak Park Community Design Commission and Historic Preservation Commission may make nominations. The judges' decisions will be based upon the Historic Preservation Commission's *Architectural Review Guidelines*, which are based on the [Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation](#), as well as considerations of contextual and design appropriateness.

Awards will be presented in conjunction with National Preservation Month in May.
