Transportation Commission to review testimony from Madison Street area parking hearings

In preparation for submitting recommendations to the Village Board, the Transportation Commission will meet to review the public testimony taken at the three recent hearings on a study of parking in the greater Madison Street/East Avenue area. The meeting will be held at at 7:30 p.m., Mon., April 27, in Village Hall, 123 Madison St.

Village staff and members of the Transportation Commission spent the past several months analyzing parking and transportation conditions in the area bounded by the Eisenhower Expressway, South Boulevard, Ridgeland Avenue and Oak Park Avenue.

Concerns the study team sought to address included commuter parking, parking in commercial districts and near local institutions, special event parking, overnight and 24-hour parking availability, traffic volume and safety, overnight guest parking and administrative and enforcement issues.
