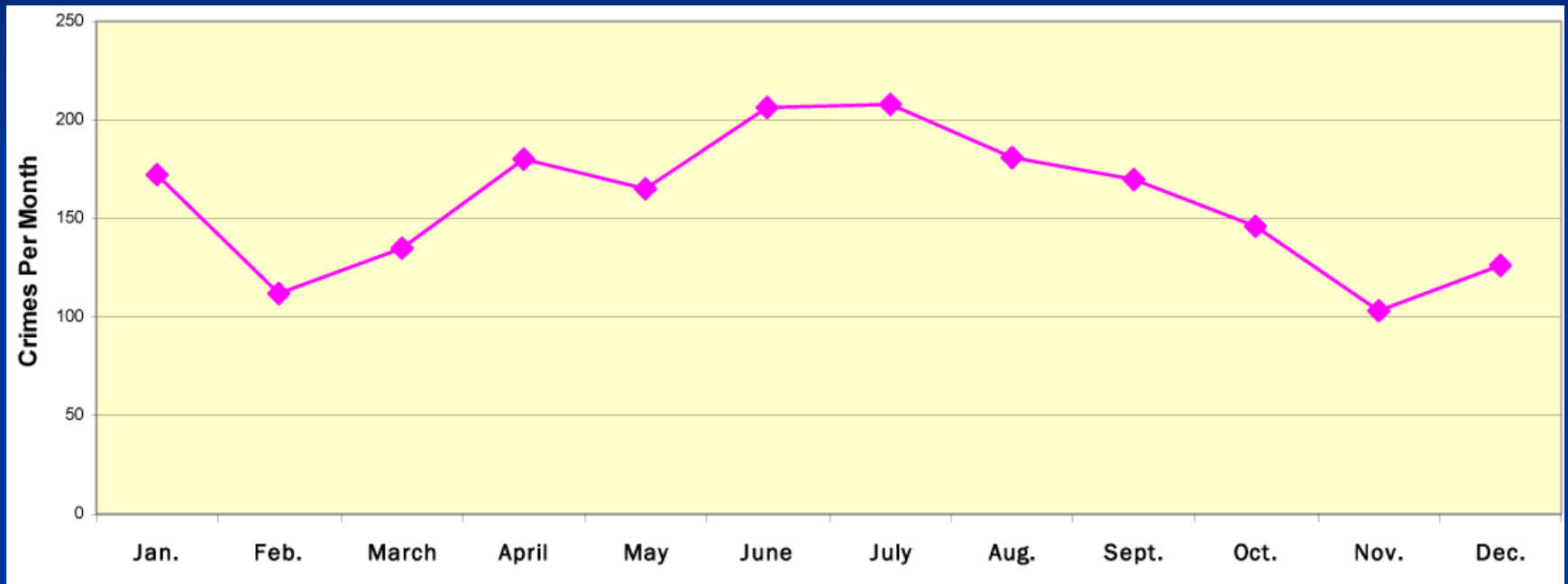

Eight out of 10 respondents who rated their encounters with Oak Park police – about a third of them nonresidents – said they were either:

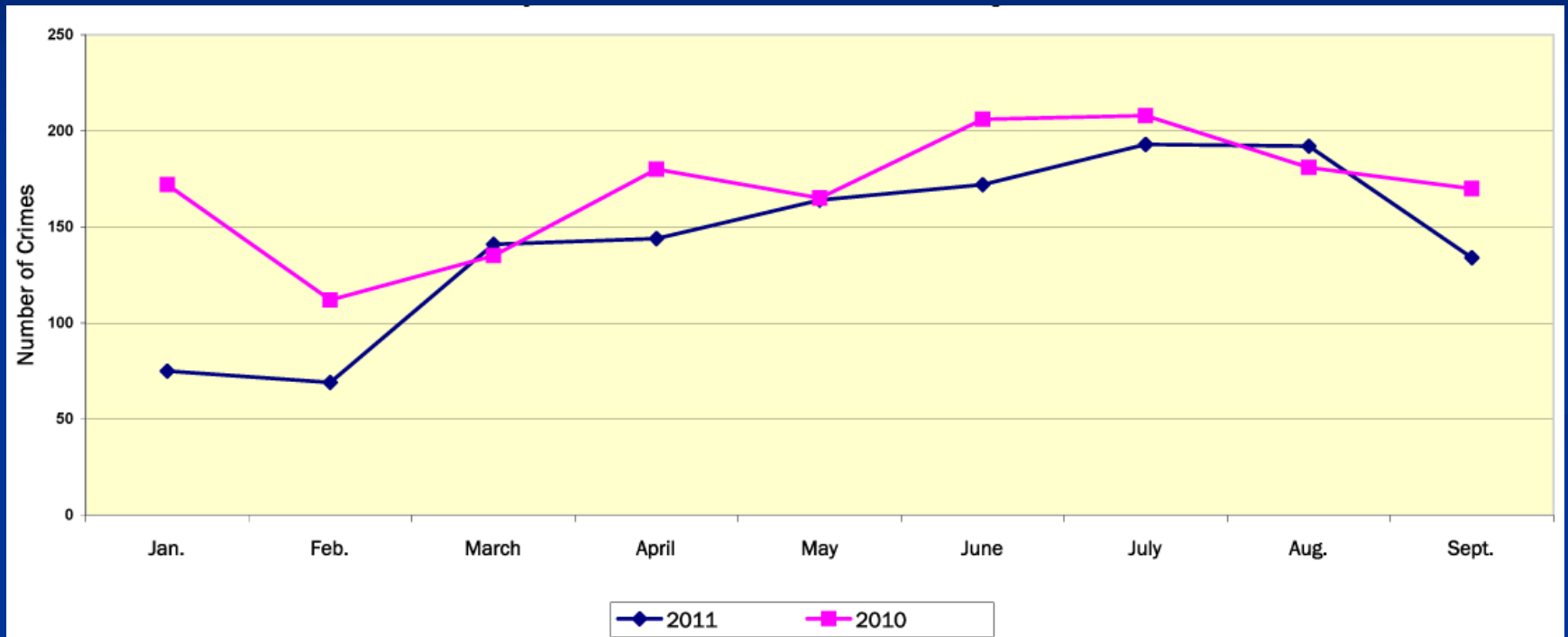
- very satisfied (72.5 percent)
- somewhat satisfied (14.2 percent) with the way they were treated by the officer.
- they reported that the officer listened to them (92.5 percent)
- was fair and evenhanded (89.1 percent)
- was polite (95 percent)
- showed concern for their feelings (79.3 percent)
- knew what he or she was doing (95 percent)

# Part 1 Crime Comparison 2010 - 2011

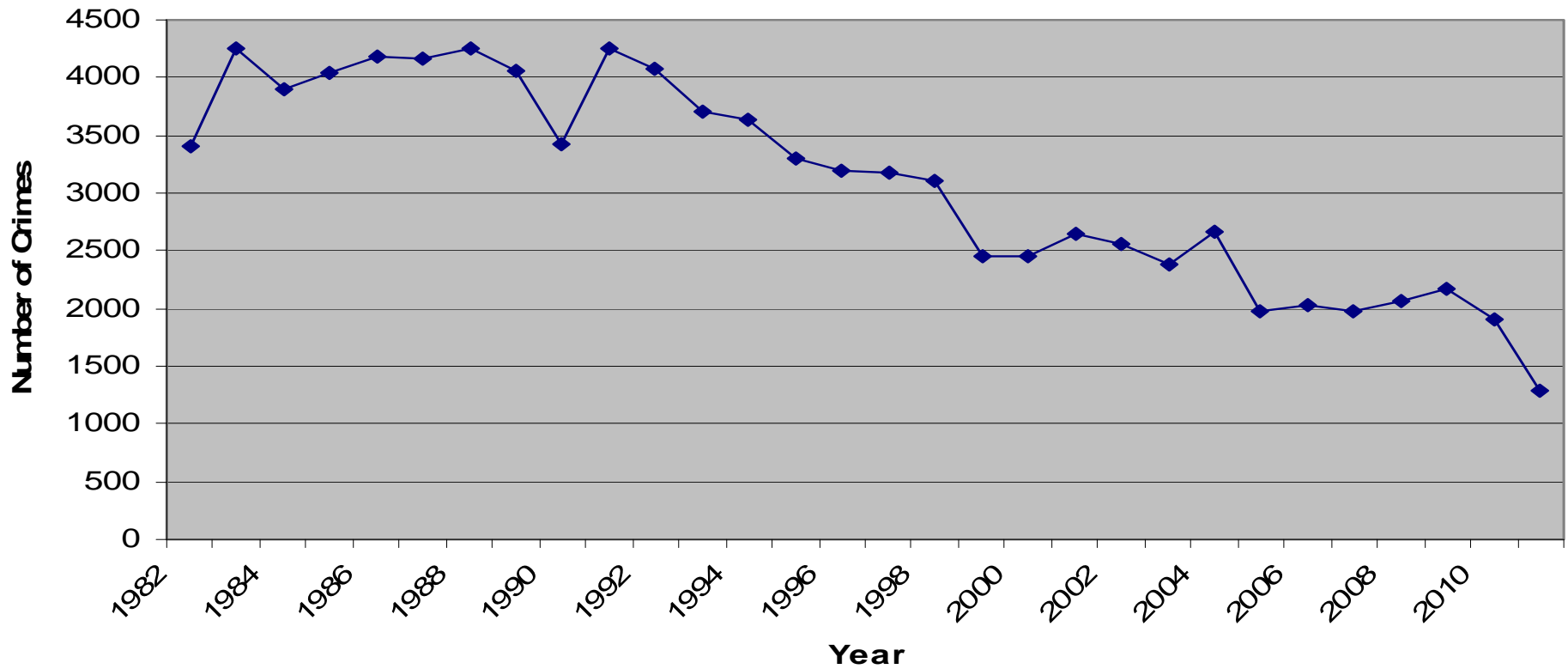

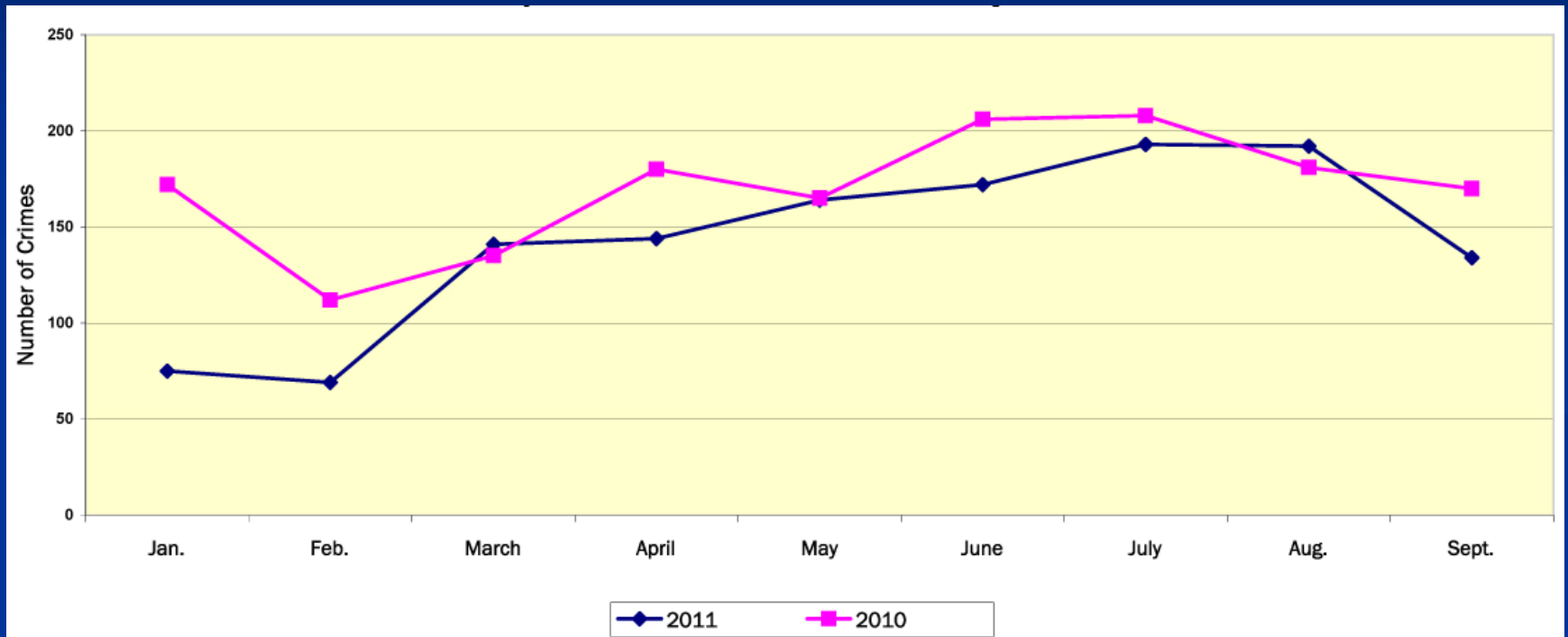

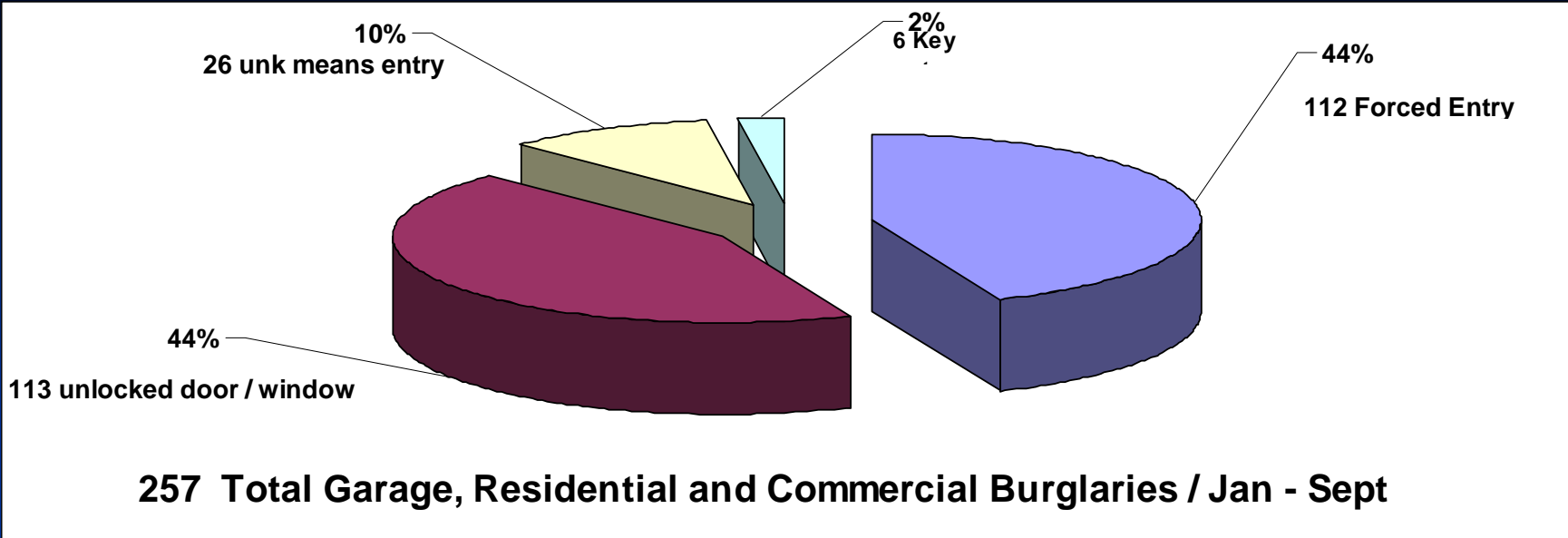

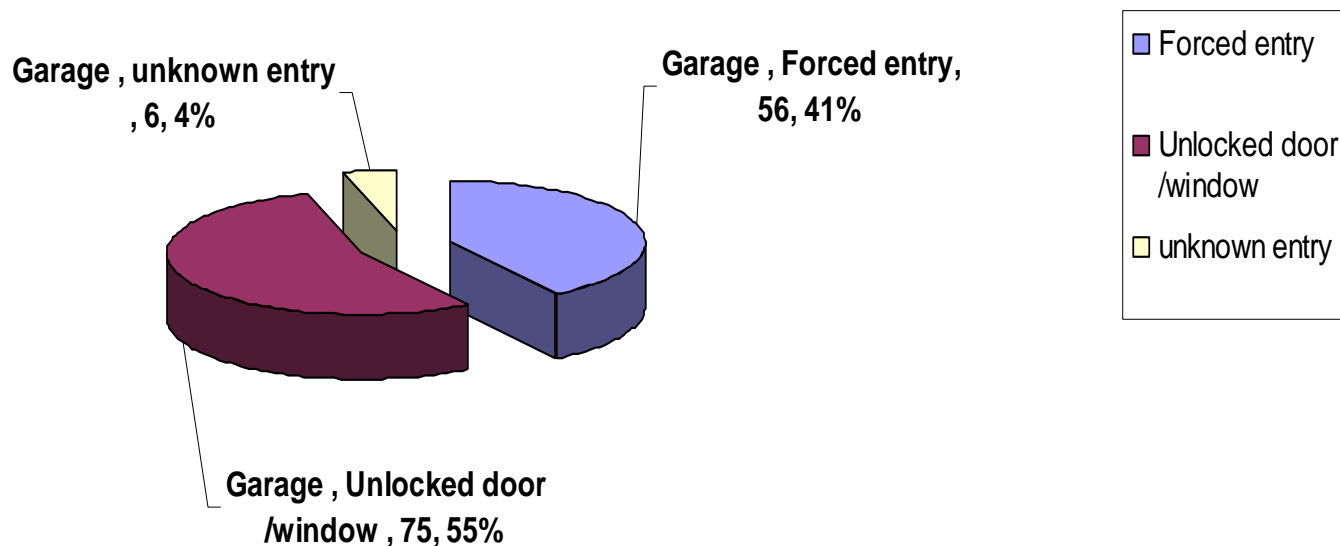

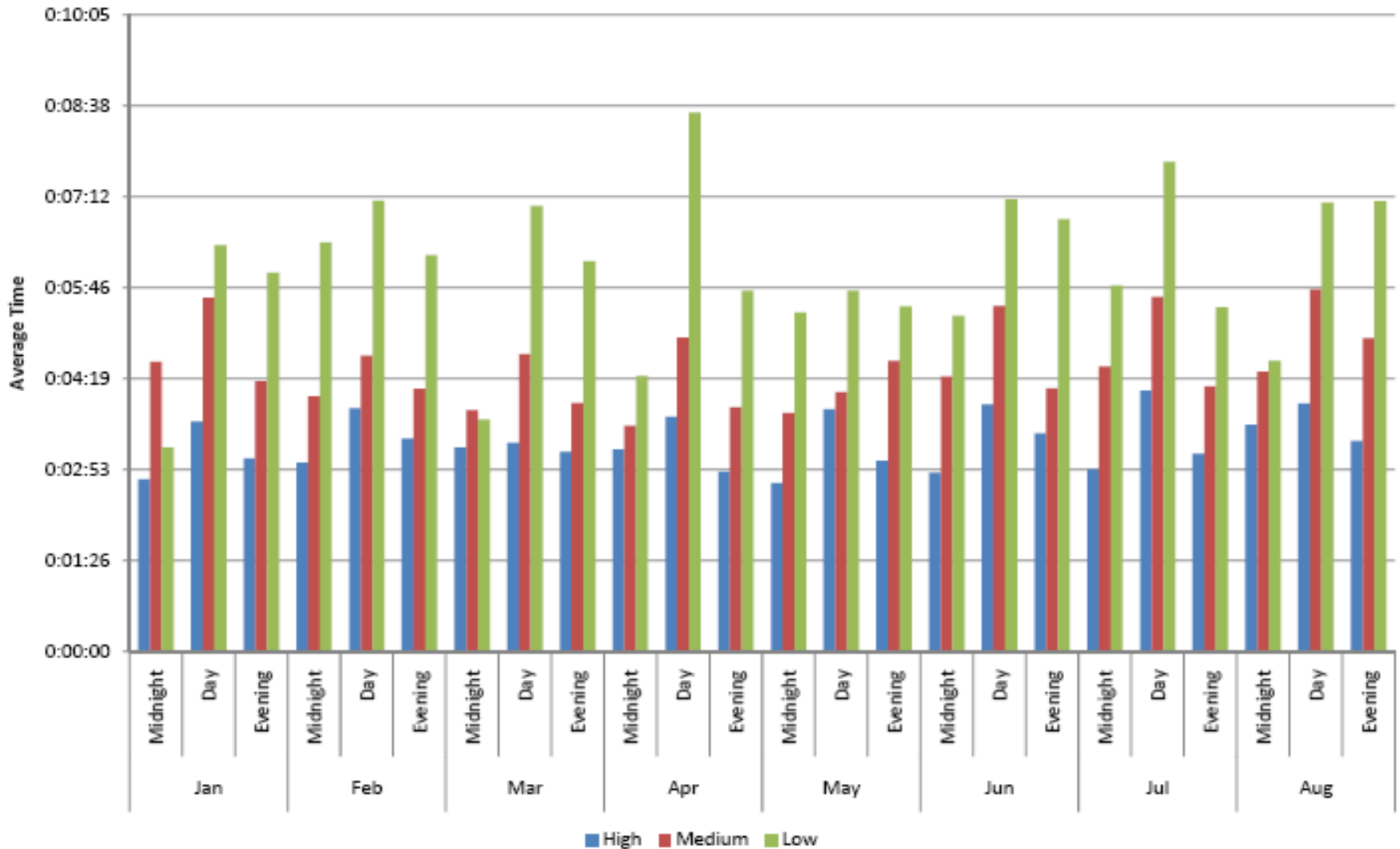

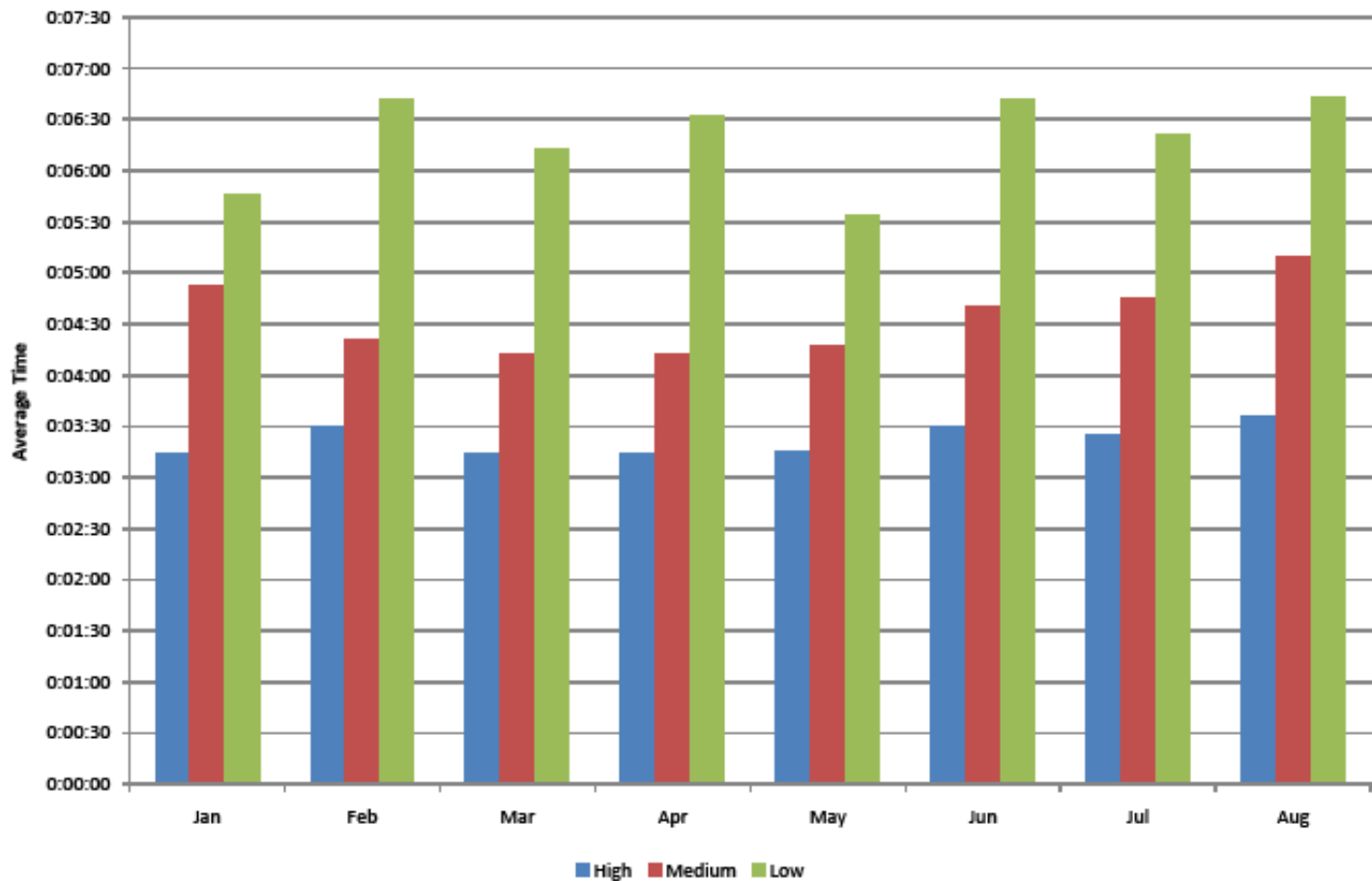

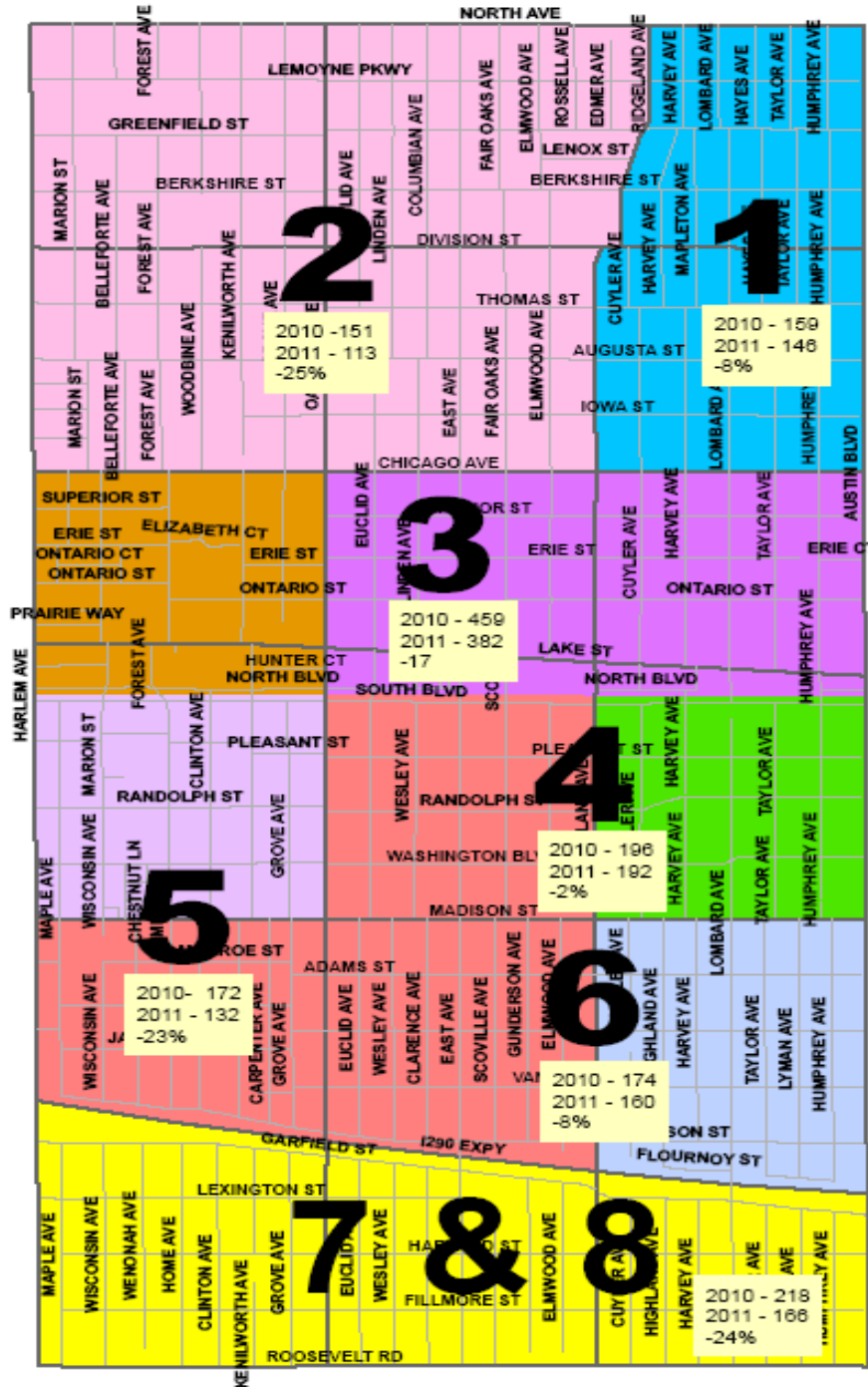
