



**Police investigating bank robbery
Dec. 3, 2008**

Oak Park Police are investigating a robbery that occurred at approximately 2:40 p.m., Wed., December 3, at the Charter One Bank at 810 S. Oak Park Avenue.

An unknown male entered the bank, presented a note to a female teller demanding money. The teller turned over an undetermined amount of U.S. currency and the subject fled the bank.

The suspect is described as African American, in his mid-20s, five feet, eight inches tall, weighing approximately 215 pounds. He was wearing a dark knit cap with a brim and a white jacket with stripes on the sleeves.

Only one customer was in the bank at the time of the incident and was threatened or injured.

Police responded to a 9-1-1 call from bank personnel made just after the incident occurred.

The Violent Crimes Task Force of the Chicago FBI was notified and, as is typical in these types of incidents, will lead the investigation.
