Dear Resident:

The Village of Oak Park awarded a contract to Cerniglia Company of Melrose Park, Illinois for the repair of the sinkhole at the northeast corner of Erie and Scoville. The sinkhole formed due to a large hole in a sewer that is approximately 30 feet below ground. To minimize the impact to the school and residents, the Village elected to do the repair using a method that requires minimal digging. The contractor will start the repair work the week of April 28<sup>th</sup>, spring break for OPRF High School. The majority of the project will take approximately 3 weeks to complete, with an additional week of work required approximately one month after the initial repair is completed.

During construction you will be inconvenienced for a time. The intersection of Erie & Scoville will be closed to most traffic during the project. The only traffic allowed into the intersection will be eastbound traffic on Erie which will be forced to turn south onto Scoville to accommodate school drop off and pick up.
