I hereby apply for a Security Improvement Grant on the above-listed building. I understand that this is a matching grant (private:public money) of 80/20% or 60/40%, up to \$200 or \$400 per unit, maximum \$8,000 or \$16,000 grant, respectively, per building. I further understand that building licenses and water bills on all buildings in Oak Park owned by this same owner must be current; said buildings must be in compliance with Oak Park's Housing Code and Chapter 13 (Human Rights) of the Village Code; and owners(s) must offer the Model Lease Addendum approved by the Village Board to any tenant who so requests it. I understand that this application must be approved by the Community Services, Finance, Community Relations, Police, Fire and Code Administration Departments of the Village of Oak Park prior to approval by the Village President and Board of Trustees. Finally, I understand that work covered by this grant MUST be completed within 6 months of grant approval or grant funds will revert to the Village, and that each building is limited to one grant every three years (from date of grant approval).
