Vehicle Sticker Sales, Renewals Underway

New vehicle stickers, which must be displayed by midnight June 30, are now on sale at the Office of the Village Clerk in Village Hall, 123 Madison St. Stickers may be purchased in person or by mail.

The Office of the Village Clerk will be open until 7:30 p.m. Mondays and Thursdays and from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. Saturdays throughout June for the convenience of residents. Regular hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The fee for the 2002 sticker is \$45 – \$35 for residents 65 and over and the disabled. Fees increase \$5 on the second day of each month beginning July 2. Vehicles not displaying a valid vehicle sticker are subject to ticketing. The fine for not displaying a valid vehicle sticker is \$21 and increases to \$31 after 14 days, in addition to the cost of the sticker and late fees.

Owners who previously purchased vehicle stickers should receive a renewal application form in the mail. Incorrect information on the form should be corrected. A copy of the vehicle's state license plate registration form must accompany a corrected form. Vehicle owners who do not receive a pre-printed form also are required to purchase a sticker.

Vehicle owners renewing by mail should return both parts of the form, along with a check payable to the Village of Oak Park, in the envelope provided. If the form does not indicate a specific fee, refer to the fee schedule printed on the form.

Automobile and truck stickers must be placed in the lower corner of the passenger side of the front windshield. Motorcycle and moped stickers go on the rear of the state plate.
