Public invited to discuss future of Roosevelt Road

The Village of Oak Park and City of Berwyn will host a public meeting at 6 p.m., Wed., June 26, to continue discussions on how to improve the economic vitality of Roosevelt Road. The meeting will be held at Duke's Roadhouse, 6319 Roosevelt Road in Berwyn, near Cuyler Avenue.

Officials will present the results of a recent direct mail survey of area business and residential property owners intended to gather information to help assess the current and future needs of this important east-west corridor the two communities share.

In addition to survey results, officials also will present other recommendations for improving the business corridor, while being sensitive to the concerns of residents whose properties abut commercial areas.

Wednesday's meeting will be the second held with area businesses and residents since Oak Park and Berwyn began a cooperative study to create a vision for strengthening the economic vitality of the Roosevelt Road corridor.
