TWO UNKNOWN M/B'S THEN ENTERED THE BUSINESS AND BROUGHT THE VICTIM OUTSIDE WHERE THEY BEGAN TO BATTER HIM. SUBJECTS REMOVED THE VICTIM'S APPLE IPHONE 13, AND SILVER AP WATCH. VICTIM DISCOVERED HIS KEYS WERE MISSING AND STATED ONE OF THE FEMALES DROVE OFF IN HIS WHITE 2016 MERCEDES-BENZ THAT HAD NO REGISTRATION AND THAT HE DID NOT RECALL WHERE HE HAD PARKED.
