NARRATIVE: OFFENDER: M/H OR M/MENA, 30'S YOA, MEDIUM BUILD WITH TATTOO'S, WEARING BLUE JEANS, DROVE SOUTHBOUND THROUGH THE ALLEY IN A WHITE VOLVO BEARING CALIFORNIA PLATES AND STOPPED IN FRONT OF THE VICTIM'S GARAGE. OFFENDER ASKED IF THE VICTIM WOULD LIKE RINGS. THE VICTIM APPROACHED THE OFFENDERS VEHICLE, OFFENDER HANDED THE VICTIM THE RINGS AND PROCEEDED TO HOLD THE VICTIM'S SHOULDERS USING FORCE AND REMOVED HIS GOLD CHAIN WITH A LION THAT HAS DIAMONDS AS EYES AND HIS FAMILY INITIALS ON THE BACK, WHILE OFFENDER#2 HELPED FROM THE BACK SEAT. OFFENDER WAS LAST SEEN DRIVING SOUTHBOUND THE ALLEY AND TURNED WESTBOUND. ESTIMATED LOSS \$5,000.00.
