COVID-19 Oak Park Business Community Update

Dear Oak Park business owners and operators:

The State of Illinois has issued [Phase 3 guidelines for business operations](#) as well as [business toolkits](#) containing resources to help you comply with public health recommendations.

Phase 3 guidelines span 10 different industry categories. Each category includes a common set of guidelines that all employers and activity types are expected and encouraged to follow, as well as workplace and program-specific guidelines.

While the State has not yet set an official date for moving into Phase 3, the Village of Oak Park is planning for this to occur as early as Friday, May 29.
