**COVID-19 Status Report
Oak Park Village Board of Trustees**

To: Village President and Village Board of Trustees

The memo is a means to share a brief summary of information regarding Village of Oak Park operational activities in response to COVID-19. In most cases, formal public guidance or employee guidance has been publicly disseminated via the Village website or Village social media channels.

New Public Health Guidance

Today, the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health received notification of the following new COVID-19 cases:

- Reported on 05/10/2020: 3 Oak Park residents
- Reported on 05/11/2020: 6 Oak Park residents

The above newly reported Oak Park cases are in their <20's or 80's.

Excluding individuals for which street addresses are not yet determined, the State of Illinois reports a total of two-hundred and sixteen (216) total Oak Park COVID-19 cases. It is important to note that as patient tracking and case follow-up occurs, individuals listed within the number of Oak Park cases reported may change depending on residency confirmation.

The positive case reported today of an individual under the age of 20 is a child who lives with other adult members of the household who have also tested positive.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is notified of positive tests as established by state and local public health protocol. Because of privacy laws, no additional information can be released about the individuals. It is noted, that privacy precludes location information regarding individuals tested to anyone other than Public Health Officials and First Responders.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is working closely with officials from the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), investigating and notifying anyone who may have had exposure to the individual who tested positive for COVID-19. Local public health officials, hospitals and first responders are following protocols consistent with the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Cases related to Long-Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities

Public Health Director Charley reported that information related to cases for residents in Long-Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities remained unchanged today.

Village Employee Tests Positive

Today, the Village received notification that a Village employee has tested positive for COVID-19. This is the fourth Village employee and this individual has not been in the workplace during the past 14 days and therefore no other employees or members of the public have been in direct contact with the employee. The employee is not a part of either the Police or Fire Department.
